invites you and your class to participate in an **interactive educational program** on organ and tissue donation – free of charge. We will even provide **free transportation** from your school to our facility.

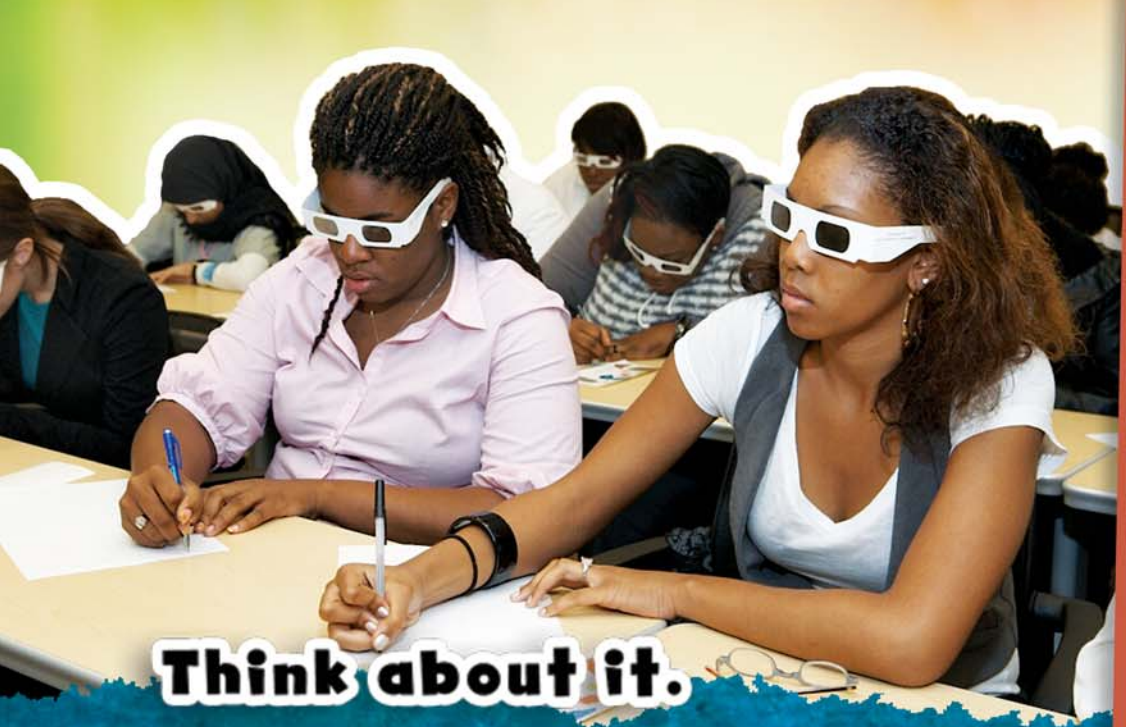
