

Tips for Field Trips

- ✓ All students participating on field trip must have a liability waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- ✓ There will need to be 1 adult per 25 students.
- ✓ Have a discussion with students informing them of the environment and content of field trip. Students should feel comfortable about going into the Operating Rooms. Please identify students that are not comfortable upon arrival. These students will remain in the classroom during the tour, and **you must provide adult supervision for them.**
- ✓ Students must have eaten breakfast or a snack prior to arriving at MTS.
- ✓ Show your students the YouTube video of the field trip. Also, encourage students to visit our webpage before and after their field trip to MTS.
- ✓ Make sure you have confirmed your number of students, pick-up day, time, and location.

During the Field Trip

- Redirect inappropriate or unruly behaviors so students and facilitator have a positive experience.
- Encourage students to participate in discussion and activities, as well as ask questions.
- Provide immediate feedback by filling out teacher survey.

After the Field Trip

- ❖ Encourage students to go home and initiate a family discussion about organ and tissue donation.
- ❖ Encourage other colleagues to take advantage of this free field trip opportunity.
- ❖ Schedule your next field trip for the following semester.
